

Cav. Francesco Musante K.G.S.J.

Chev. Francesco Musante was born in Moconesi (Genoa) on the 25 July, 1937. He lives in Chiavari where he has been active for a long number of years. During these last 27 years he has produced more than six volumes of lyrical verse. His works have been appeared in every continent through the intervention of over fifteen National and International Academies. Amongst his works we find

- “Alzo Lo Sguardo” (1977)
- “Serenita della Fede” (1980)
- “I Canti Dell’ Anima” (1999)
- “Chiavari - Provincia”, an illustrated album with over a hundred coloured photos enriched with lyrical verse in which the poet sings in praise of his beloved town (2001)
- “Rievocazione Storica dei Santuari Mariani della Diocesi di Chiavari” in which he features a poem to each of the eleven churches dedicated to Our Lady, all of which churches are to be found in the town of Chiavari.

Amongst the honours he received there are the

- “Oscar del Golfo di Napoli” (1983)
- “Oscar Universale Citta di Tabiano Terme” (1982)
- “Oscar del Mare Citta di Roma” (2000).

Besides being a member of the Sovereign Order of St. John of Jerusalem, Chev. Francesco Musante is also a “Cavaliere di Merito dell’Ordine Militare del Santissimo Salvatore e di Santa Brigida di Svezia” (Knight of Honour of the Military Order of the Holy Saviour and of St. Brigida of Sweden). He has also received academic honours from the State of Missouri, from Lebanon, Portugal and from various academic institutes in Italy.
